Sanction is hereby accorded to the release of funds amounting to Rs 61.23 lacs for providing livelihood and nutritional support to the left over fishermen of 2021-22 through PFMS mode as Central Share under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme "PMMSY" 2021-22 in favour of the DDOs as detailed in Annexure "A". The scheme should be implemented strictly as per norms & guidelines of the Ministry of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry & Dairying, Department of Fisheries and instructions issued by the J&K Government from time to time. The concerned Joint Directors shall monitor the implementation of the scheme regularly.


**The Allotment is subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions**

1. Operational Guidelines of the PMMSY should be adhered strictly.
2. The DDOs will ensure utilization of the central funds strictly as per the Terms and Conditions (T&C) of the sanction and for the purpose for which it is released.
3. No diversion of central funds for any other purpose shall be allowed. In case, the DDO fails to utilize the sanctioned central funds under PMMSY, they shall return the same along with accrued interest thereon, if any.
4. The DDOs shall maintain and preserve proper record on the expenditure incurred on implementation of the approved activity, produce the same as and when desired by this Directorate.
5. No deviation in the approved activity shall be permitted without the prior approval of the Department of Fisheries, Ministry of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying. In case, the approved Livelihood activity needs to be revised with any addition/deletion/modification on account of any unavoidable circumstances, then the prior approval shall be obtained from the competent authority.
6. The DDOs shall complete release of Livelihood support to the enrolled beneficiaries left over fishermen of 2021-22, as approved under the Livelihood activity of PMMSY. The concerned District/Project officer will also ensure release/utilization of beneficiary contribution.



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7. The DDOs shall regularly submit physical and financial progress reports on implementation of the approved activity on monthly basis.
8. The DDOs will ensure transfer of benefits to the beneficiaries through Direct Beneficiary Transfer (DBT) platform in to their Bank accounts.
9. The DDOs will ensure that the expenditure incurred on implementation of the approved activity is strictly in accordance with the provisions of PMMSY and also GFR2017.
10. The DDOs will submit the Physical and Financial MPR under the scheme before 2<sup>nd</sup> day of every month along with DBT information.


