<u>ABSTRACT</u>

Fingerlings of Tor putirora were collected from Anji stream (Reasi) in district Udhampur of J&K State since 1995 and a stock of 300 brooders was maintained the brooders were fed on Mustered oil cake and Rice bran supplemented with Sheep/Goat lungs, six months before breeding. During September 1999, the farm reared brooders were given a single dose of Ovaprim and fertilized eggs.were obtained by stripping. Subsequent hatching was done in trays at a specially designed hatchery yielding 5000 fry.
